Arab and Kurdish crime clans 'Systematically recruiting' refugees in Merkel's Germany



Arab and Kurdish crime clans are "systematically recruiting" refugees and building parallel societies in Germany, an investigation has found.

"The clans have systematically been recruiting refugees for the dirtiest jobs, such as selling drugs in parks and the subway," Thomas Spaniel, an organised crime specialist with Berlin's police force, told the *Washington Post*.

Reporter Bojan Pancevski describes how thousands of Arabs and Kurds who arrived as asylum seekers from Lebanon and Turkey in the 1980s and, according to a report by the authorities, "stuck by tribal and Islamic codes of justice, spurning the state and its laws", resulting in some large families turning into "criminal enterprises" operating according to "their own rules and hierarchies".

Pancevski reports that Berlin's organised crime scene is dominated by around a dozen mostly Arab and Kurdish crime clans with comprising roughly a thousand individual criminals — but that the criminal ecosystem has been upset by more recent migration waves, with ugly consequences.

"Now it's like New York here: Chechens, Kurds, Albanians, Russians, Moroccans, Turks, Gypsies... Everyone wants their share," one gangster told Pancevski at a funeral for Nidal Rabih, a notorious gang enforcer who was riddled with eight bullets in a public park in front of his wife and children.

More than 2,000 people attended the funeral, with the *Washington Post* reporter's interlocutor vowing that those responsible for the killing "will pay".

Their overrepresentation in the figures for suspects in unlawful killing, assault, and robbery statistics is even more striking, at around 14 percent.

The figures appear to lend credence — perhaps unintentionally — to U.S. President Donald Trump's recent claim that migrants have "violently changed" Germany's culture.
