

Who is Ibrahim Aqil, target of Israel's Beirut strike? - explainer

Ibrahim Aqil, also known as Tahsin, “serves on Hezbollah’s highest military body, the Jihad Council.”

Israel’s attack in Beirut on Friday afternoon allegedly targeted the head of Hezbollah’s Operations Division, Ibrahim Aliq, Israeli media confirmed on Friday morning.

So, who is this leader in the terrorist organization, and why did Israel allegedly want to take him down?
